### WHO CAN APPLY

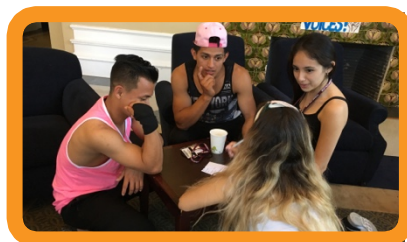
Undocumented students in New York State who are currently freshmen, sophomores, or juniors are invited to apply.
